The Brolga Recovery Group (BRG) is a community-based group focused on saving the iconic Brolga from extinction in southeastern Australia. The BRG advocates on behalf of the threatened Brolga population and investigates ways to help landholders protect and enhance wetlands and Brolga habitat on their land.

The Victorian Brolga population has suffered a steep decline in the last two decades. May 2010 counts in south west Victoria and South Australia estimate the population at 400–500 birds, down from the 1990s population of between 600–650 birds. We must not be complacent and need to continue improving our knowledge on Brolga and championing improved wetland knowledge and protection.
